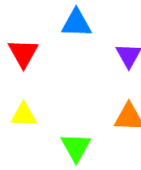

Dear Fellow Congregants:

As the Yomim Noarim approach the Shul will once again begin its seat sale. Consistent with the policy instituted by the Board in previous years, the Shul is requiring that Yom Tov seats be paid for at the time reservations are made, and that members bring their accounts with the Shul current before seats can be reserved at the membership rate. For this purpose, accounts are deemed current if all past due obligations are paid in full. This would include dues from prior years as well as all other pledges (including any past due building fund obligations), but would not include 2011-2012 dues or other obligations that have not yet become due. If you have any questions about the status of your account with the Shul, please review the statement of your account which will be sent shortly by email or speak to the Treasurer, Alan Wengrofsky. As always, if circumstances do not permit you to either pay your past due obligations or pay for your Yom Tov seats please speak to the President, Josh Lieber or Alan. All conversations will remain confidential.

There will be four minyanim at Anshei for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur this year: 1) Main sanctuary, 2) Social Hall, 3) Sephardic, and 4) Neitz Minyan. The sale of seats applies to all minyanim. The prices for Yom Tov seats for this year are the same for all minyanim and are as follows: \$75 for members, \$100 for family of members and \$150 for non-members. The price is the same whether you will be here for only one of the Yomim Noarim or both.

EARLY SALE: The Early Sale of seats begins immediately and will continue through August 25, 2011. Orders may be placed and paid for by credit card via our web site at <https://www.anshei.org/payments.php> or **by mail** (PO Box 410, West Hempstead, NY 11552) and are payable by check or credit card. To order you must: a) be current with your Shul account, b) pay for your seats and c) mail your seat reservation form (see attached). Your seats will be at your choice either a) the same as last year or b) an area that you request to the extent available. **However, the Seating Committee cannot guarantee that you will get the seat of your choice.** If you cannot become current with your account at this time please call Josh or Alan to make arrangements and participate in the Early Sale.

REGULAR SALE: The Regular Sale of seats will take place at the Shul on Saturday night, September 10., from 9:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. Please bring a check or credit card (Visa/MC) to cover the cost of your seats and any past due obligations to the Shul. You will not be able to reserve seats until you have received clearance from the Treasurer that the seats are paid and your account is current. **The Treasurer will not be discussing accounts on these nights and will only be available to accept payments. Please settle open issues on your account BEFORE you arrive. Seating for the Regular Sale is on an available basis (i.e., Early Sale has preference as to a particular seat.)** Nonmembers will not be permitted to purchase seats until after August 25.

In an attempt to accommodate all adults, no seats will be sold for a child under 4th grade level. Enclosed with this letter is a seating form. Please mail it back with payment to participate in the Early Sale or bring it with you to the Regular Sale.

If you have any questions about the process for reserving Yom Tov seats, please feel free to speak to any Board member. The Board would like to thank Lara Kahn, Shua Horowitz, Jack Gourdji and Jeff Beer for coordinating seat assignments at the Minyanim.
